Press Release

According to the approval of **Samdech Akka Moha Sena Padei Techo Hun Sen, Prime Minister of the Kingdom of Cambodia**, dated 16 March 2022 on the report dated 15 March 2022 of the Covid-19 Committee, the Inter-Ministerial Committee for Combating Covid-19 decides as follows:

- 1- Cancel the requirement for travelers from abroad to show PCR test negative result within 72 hours before arriving in Cambodia.
- 2- Cancel the requirement for doing a rapid test when arriving in Cambodia.
- 3- Allow for Visa on Arrival for all international travelers, both air, land and waterway travelers.

Despite the cancellation of the requirement as stipulated in point 1 and 2 above, the Ministry of Health would like to encourage all travelers to do a rapid test by themselves. Meanwhile, all travelers must show a certificate of Covid-19 vaccination when arriving in Cambodia.

Travelers who have not been fully vaccinated against Covid-19 must be in quarantine for 14 days at the location set by the Ministry of Health or competent authority.
